



ISC SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

Existing students of St. John's Universal School and new students seeking admission for ISC (Class XI) are eligible to apply for this Scholarship.

The scholarship is offered to students in ISC (Class XI) and to be eligible for the continuation of the scholarship in ISC (Class XII), the student must score as per the above table in ISC (Class XII – English + Best 3 Scores).

General regulations governing the scholarship plan:

- The scholarship amount is strictly restricted/calculated only on the Tuition Fees as per the Fee Structure of the grade. All other applicable fees are payable by the student.
- All decisions for the selection of students for the scholarship are at the discretion of the management and no representation will be accepted.
- Intimation of the scholarship will be made in writing signed by the management representative. No oral confirmation should be considered.
- The management at any time may withdraw scholarships offered without giving any notice. Students who have joined the school under the scholarship plan will be allowed to continue their education under the scholarship program for the Academic year in progress.
